

How to purchase

If you make a reservation on our official website or app and board the Tokaido Shinkansen, you can purchase a "Mt. Fuji-Izu Area Tourist Pass PLUS," which starts on the day or the day after you board the Shinkansen, at the station where you get off the Shinkansen.

Please present your Seat Information issued from the Shinkansen automatic ticket gate when entering with a QR Code ticket or IC card to the station attendant at the point of purchase.

* If you wish to receive your ticket after making a reservation via the App or online, you will need to present the ticket voucher and receipt issued when you receive your ticket at a reserved-seat ticket vending machine or other location.

For details on the purchase locations and the terms and conditions for purchase, please see below. All of the following conditions must be met:

① The Seat Information must be for the train on the day before or on the day of the first day of use of the Mt. Fuji-Izu Area Tourist Pass PLUS you will purchase.
Example: If you use the Mt. Fuji-Izu Area Tourist Pass PLUS on March 15, the Seat Information for a train on March 14 or 15 is valid.

② The route must be from a station outside Shizuoka Prefecture (Tokyo, Shinagawa, Shin-Yokohama or Odawara station) to the station where you purchase the Mt. Fuji-Izu Area Tourist Pass PLUS.

Example: If you ride a Shinkansen train from Tokyo station to Mishima station, you can purchase a pass at Mishima station. You cannot purchase a pass at Atami station and Shin-Fuji station.

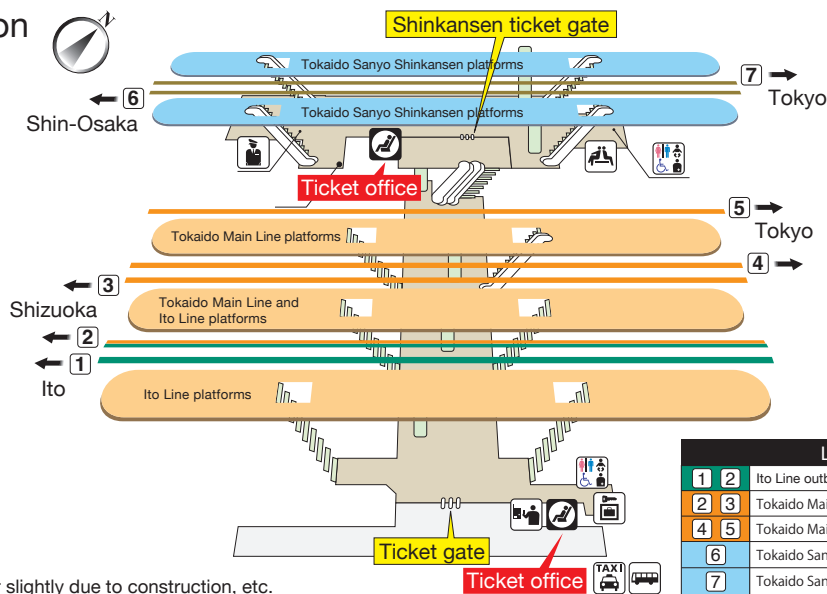
[Notes]

- Only one Mt. Fuji-Izu Area Tourist Pass PLUS can be purchased with each Seat Information or Sales Slip and Receipt.
- * The pass cannot be sold for a Shinkansen ticket.
- The effective starting date or other conditions may not be changed.
- Cannot be used in conjunction with other discounts. No transfer discount is available.
- Refunds can be made at the purchase location for a fee of 220 yen only before the effective date or during the effective period and if the pass has not been used.
- Lost passes will not be reissued.
- Depending on the route or the situation, a basic fare ticket or other open ticket may be cheaper.

Purchase locations : JR-Central Ticket Offices at Atami, Mishima and Shin-Fuji stations

* Please come to the Ticket Office after exiting the ticket gate. * The pass is not available at JR-East counters in Atami station.

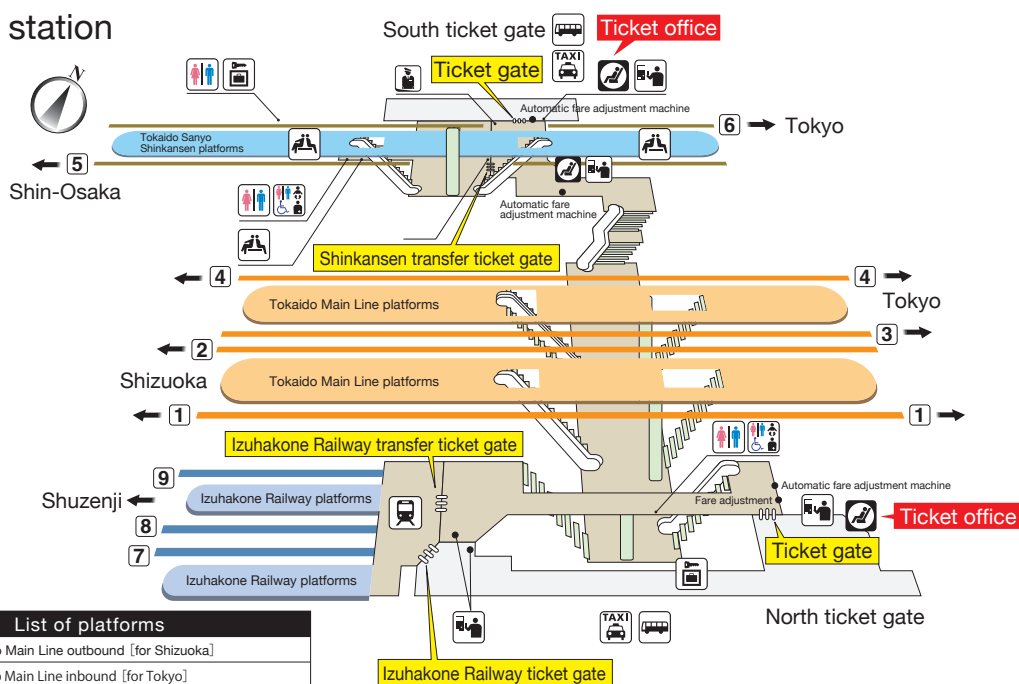
Atami station

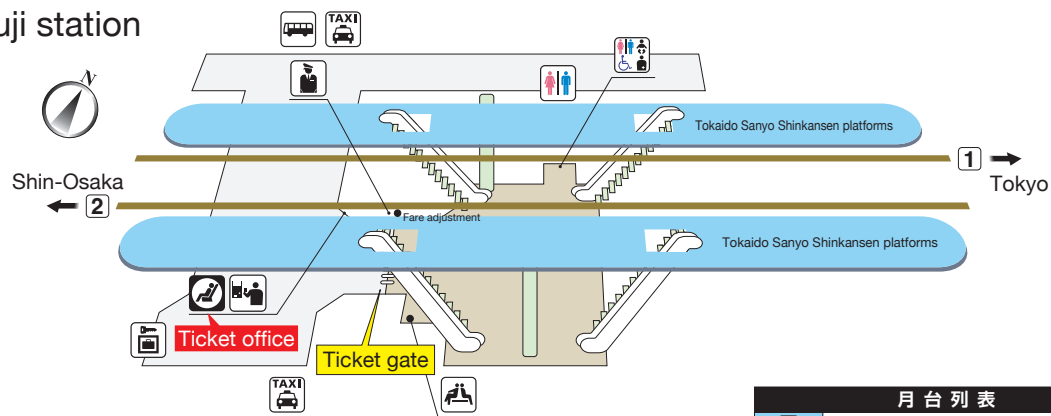
Mishima station
